Smile, It's Summer! See you soon



What Is A Crown?

A crown is an artificial cover that is used to restore, protect, and strengthen your tooth and keep it healthy.

When Would I Need One?

- If you have a tooth that has been worn down by teeth grinding, an improper bite, or decay, a crown restoration could save it.
 - Crowns will give cracked or broken teeth much-needed support.
- A tooth that has loosened due to gum disease can be stabilized by crowning it and connecting it to the neighboring teeth.
- Gaps in your smile can be replaced by incorporating a single crown onto the root of a dental implant placed into your jawbone.

What Are My Options?

Ceramic crowns are the most natural-looking and can be as translucent as your own enamel. They are the perfect choice for those with metal allergies, but people usually choose them because of how they look.

Ceramic-fused-to-metal crowns combine this natural look with the strength of metal underneath, but they are not as translucent as ceramic alone.


Many cosmetic techniques involve only a visit or two...

You can re-proportion a toogummy smile, teeth that look too short, or teeth that appear to have different lengths because their crowns are hidden beneath differing amounts of gum tissue ... or a combination of all three.

If you have ever needed dentures, you are probably well aware of the frustrating fact that they can slip, flop around, and just not sit right. But not anymore! Our office is happy to now offer a

more secure treatment for those who require dentures, finally giving you control over your restorations with implant supported dentures.

To properly explain implant-supported dentures, we should start with the implants. Implants are small anchors, usually made from titanium, that are surgically placed into existing jawbone to provide a stable base for a restoration. As time passes, these implants actually become fused to the bone giving a secure, stable base. After this healing has occurred, small posts will be attached to the implant

anchor to hold the dentures. Once your gums have completely healed your dentures can be securely fastened to the implant posts.

Implant-supported dentures provide a more stable restoration, properly

securing a floppy lower denture, and are built to last up

to twenty years without complications. Since they are designed to be like natural teeth, they can also absorb the same level of biting pressure as natural teeth – helping you to eat normally.

If you have lost one or several teeth, are unhappy with other denture options, are in good general health, have enough bone structure to support the anchor, and have healthy gums, implant-supported dentures could be right for you.
