Gain a confident smile with crowns and bridges

Crowns and Bridges. The very words denote power and strength. That's fitting because crown and bridge restorations are meant to boost your smile power while strengthening the structure of your smile.

Crowns are sometimes called caps because they fit over your teeth to support them and to improve their appearance. They are usually made of natural-looking translucent porcelain and are designed to blend in so well with neighboring teeth that no one can tell that you have them.

Where does the bridge come in? When you have one or more missing teeth, replacements are created to fill in or bridge the gap. One or both of the supporting teeth on either side may require crowns to make them strong enough to support the replacement.

Crown and bridge restorations can benefit you in so many ways – enhanced appearance, improved ability to eat and speak ... and renewed self-confidence.

You may require a crown if a tooth has:

been extensively damaged by decay; become weakened because there is more filling than tooth; been fractured, compromising its structural integrity; become discolored and detracts from your smile; undergone root canal treatment; the role of supporting a bridge.





Complete Or Partial?

Dentures can be a total smile solution

Dentures can restore your natural appearance and your ability to eat and speak. They can even help to plump out facial wrinkles. For many people – in consultation with their dentist – dentures remain the treatment of choice to replace missing teeth.

Dentures are removable, customfitted replacement teeth that are crafted from strong, durable materials like acrylic resin which can be reinforced with porcelain or metal. There are two main types of dentures: complete and partial. Overdentures are a hybrid of the two.

Complete dentures replace all of your teeth. You may require both an upper and lower prosthetic, although sometimes only an upper denture is required. They can be placed immediately after extraction or after a lengthier healing period. There are advantages and disadvantages to either approach, and we can review these together.

Partial dentures correct only the gaps in your smile by anchoring removable dentures to your natural teeth with metal clasps or nearly invisible devices called precision attachments. By filling in gaps, partials can help to prevent further decay, gum disease, or the shifting of your remaining teeth.

Overdentures are similar to complete dentures but use one or more natural teeth for support like a removable partial. In many instances, they can be attached to dental implants.

Metal-free *Empress*® restorations

Have you ever wondered why movie stars and television hosts all seem to have megawatt smiles? They make certain that their precious smiles get the maximum care and feeding dental science can provide. Now you can, too.

New and exciting *Empress*® materials mimic the form, function, and beauty of natural teeth, and are available through convenient and affordable consultations right here at our office.

Unlike traditional dentistry, Empress doesn't require unattractive metal support. Made of porcelain, with excellent translucency and strength, custommade Empress restorations provide a very natural, enamellike look. They are indistinguishable

from your own natural enamel.

Crowns – often called caps – are required when your tooth has more filling than tooth (which weakens its structure) or when the existing tooth structure becomes fractured or severely compromised, for example, from trauma.

Empress works equally well for veneers as it does for crowns. Veneers are indicated if you have a broken or chipped tooth, if your teeth have been permanently stained or discolored, or if fillings are stained or unsightly. Veneers are very thin, extremely strong shells that are bonded on the front of your teeth. They can even be used to straighten your smile, close spaces, and reshape the alignment of your teeth.

Eye-catching smiles have become the norm

New techniques, new technology, and dedicated dental professionals are behind every attractive, healthy smile you see. And a hectic schedule is no longer an excuse to procrastinate. With today's teeth-whitening techniques, you can have the look you've always dreamed of in only one or two visits.

Even a subtle change can dramatically perk up a smile. For example, replacing older fillings with white composite materials, or with inlays or onlays, can make all the difference in how you look – and feel. Teeth whitening can gently and effectively remove the unsightly stains that can build up over time from tea, coffee, ageing, and medications. You can select the degree of brightening you'd like to achieve.

Ultra-thin porcelain veneers and bonding will also lighten your teeth and cover the most stubborn stains. But at the same time, they will also correct gaps, chips,



crowding, and even the shape of your teeth. Veneers are very strong thin shells of porcelain that are permanently affixed to your natural teeth. Bonding uses a special tooth-colored material that adheres directly to your teeth. The results of both procedures look completely natural and can strengthen your natural tooth structure.

Shine Up Your Smile Say goodbye to dental discoloration



Do you shy away from being photographed or avoid smiling because your teeth are stained or dark? You are not alone. The number-one esthetic concern among dental patients is discolored teeth.

Even if your teeth are severely stained from smoking, coffee, tea, or ageing, we can safely and effectively lighten them. Many off-the-shelf whiteners are ineffective: the best method of tooth whitening is under our office's supervision.

Tooth whitening involves the lightening of dental discoloration by application of a whitening agent. If you're in a hurry for brighter teeth, we can provide inoffice whitening. More often we will suggest a dentist supervised at-home whitening, which is more economical and offers much the same results – safely and predictably.

During your first appointment we'll take an impression of your teeth and create your custom-fitted whitening tray. It's lightweight and can be worn comfortably over your teeth. You'll also receive whitening materials and instructions. Previously it was recommended you wear the trays for several hours or overnight. We now have better whitening materials and recommend wearing the appliance 1 hour a day for 2 to 4 weeks, although longer use will produce even whiter teeth.

Lightening lasts from six months to five years, depending on exposure to smoking, red wine, coffee or tea. We can easily re-whiten your teeth. Let us know if you're interested in tooth whitening. Within two weeks your smile can be clean, bright, and white!
